

2ND GEN TACOMA **Skid Plates**

installation instructions



• Front Skid Install

After removing the factory skids, reuse the 4-12mm bolts from factory skid to install the front portion of the new CBI skid.



Hardware:

- □ 1 ¾" x 1" bolt
- ☐ 1 ¾" Flange Nuts
- ☐ 1 ¾" SAE Washers
- $2 \frac{7}{16}$ " x 3 ½" bolts
- ☐ 2 ⁷/₁₆" Flange Nuts
- **□** 2 ⁷/₁₆" SAE Washers
- ☐ 2 square heavy washers
- \Box 4 ½" x 1 ¼" button head bolts
- ☐ 2 ½" Flange Nuts
- ☐ 2 ½" SAE Washers
- \square 2 8mm x 30mm bolts
- ☐ 2 5/16" USS Washers
- 8 Round heavy washers

• Mid Skid Install

The mid skid bolts to the back of the front skid using 2 – ½" x 1 ½" button heads, ½" washers and ½" flange nuts. The back of the mid skid will need to be spaced down from the cross member using the suppled round heavy washers.

2 – 8mm x 30mm bolts and 5/16" washers threaded into the captured nuts on the cross member secure the rear of the mid skid.



•Rear Skid Install

Attach the front of the rear skid to the back of the mid skid using $2 - \frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " button heads, $\frac{1}{2}$ " washers and $\frac{1}{2}$ " flange nuts. For the side tabs, run the $2 - \frac{7}{16}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " bolts up through the cross member. On the back side of the cross member place a square washer, $\frac{7}{16}$ " washers and $\frac{7}{16}$ " flange nut.



• Final install

For the rear frame braces re-use the 8mm bolt used to attach the brake lines to the frame on the drivers side as shown. On the passenger side use the supplied %" bolt, washer and nut to secure the frame brace to the frame.
